# DISTRICT LEVEL TEACHERS' CONCLAVE 2025 FOR KARBI ANGLONG & WEST KARBI ANGLONG

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### Introduction:-

The District Institute of Education and Training (DIET), Karbi Anglong successfully organized a three-day District Level Teachers' Conclave on Pedagogical Leadership and Innovation from 15<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October 2025 at Diphu. The conclave brought together educators, headmasters, BRP, CRCCs and teachers totaling 100 nos. from across 11 educational blocks covering both Karbi Anglong and West Karbi Anglong district to deliberate on effective Pedagogical Leadership, innovative classroom practices, and strategies to strengthen foundational learning.

The event served as a collaborative platform for educators to exchange experiences, share success stories and reflect on leadership roles that promote inclusive, quality and sustainable education.

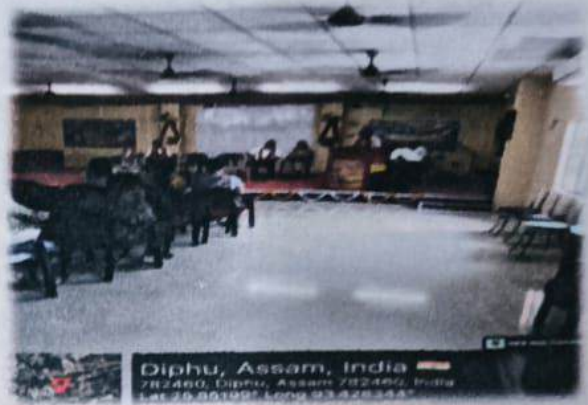

## Day-wise Summary of Activities:

### Day 1: Inauguration and Knowledge Sharing (15<sup>th</sup> October 2025)

The inaugural day began with the registration and arrival of guest and participants from 11 educational blocks of both Karbi Anglong and West Karbi Anglong, District. This was followed by the arrival of dignitaries, educational officers, and the Guest of Honour, Shri Biren Sing Engti, Inspector of Schools, KADC, along with Shri Dhonsing Timung, Principal, BTC. The formal opening of the event was marked by the ceremonial lighting of the lamp.



- The Welcome Address was delivered by Shri Lakhya Jyoti Saikia, Lecturer, DIET, who emphasized the importance of continuous professional development and innovative pedagogical practices.
- This was followed by a Felicitation ceremony, honoring distinguished educators and contributors to the district's education sector.
- The Keynote Address was delivered by Shri Pranjal Chetia, Lecturer, DIET,K/A, who highlighted the significance of pedagogical leadership in achieving the objectives of NEP 2020 and the role of teachers as change makers in the education system.

### Session 1- Thematic Presentation on Foundational Literacy and Numeracy:

Participants presented innovative strategies and classroom practices aimed at strengthening foundational learning:

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- Shri Prasanjit Dey (Samelangso Block) – Innovative approaches to foundational Numeracy.
- Shri Sonu Gupta (Nilip Block) - Integration of FLN and ECCE to ensure holistic child development.
- Shri Kamson Ronghang (Chinthong Block) – Effective strategies for teaching basic numeracy skills at the primary level.



### Session 2- Innovative Practices in ECCE (Early Childhood Care and Education)

After lunch, the second session featured innovative classroom-based practices:

- Shri Dibya Jyoti Barkakati (Howraghat Block) - Creative methods of English Vocabulary Learning.
- Shri Arwinson Rongphar (Rongmongve Block) – Innovative Practices in FLN for student engagement.
- Smti. Sunumai Basumatary (Howraghat Block) – Effective Alphabet Teaching Processes for beginners.

The day concluded with Chairperson's Remarks, summarizing the importance of collaboration and reflective practices in promoting effective pedagogy.

### Day 2: Workshops and Collaborative Learning (16<sup>th</sup> October 2025):

The Second day focused on themes like innovative Pedagogy in classroom for enhancement of Learning of Students, effective Leadership practice for school transformation and assessment for holistic development of students.

### Session 3- Leadership



- Shri Harish Chand Chauhan (Howraghat Block) delivered a talk on Effective Leadership Practices for School Transformation.



- Shri Satyajeet Sonar (Bokajan Block) presented on Leadership, emphasizing the need to develop student leadership through participatory learning.
- Shri Prafulla Saikia (Nilip Block) spoke on empowering students through leadership and motivation, sharing practical examples of peer mentoring.

#### Session 4- Best Practices and sustainability initiatives.

The session combined pedagogical innovation with sustainability and resource optimization:

- Shri Bijoy Dey (Bokajan Block) demonstrated use of unused single used plastic for creating low-cost teaching aids.
- Shri Sangeet Bhowmik (Lumbajong Block) presented Mind Mapping as a Learning Strategy, showcasing its benefits in critical thinking and concept retention.
- Shri Binod Kumar Chetri (Nilip Block) spoke on Student empowerment through classroom leadership, sharing his school's best practices.

The day ended with a reflective discussion and closing remarks, reinforcing the idea of "Pedagogical Leadership with Innovation".

Day 3: Best Practices on use of ICT, feedback session and Valediction (17<sup>th</sup> October 2025)

Session 6 – Demonstration of Best Practices

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- Shri Raktim Kumar Nath (Rongkhan Block) showcased Best Practices in Mathematics using ICT, demonstrating how digital tools enhance conceptual understanding.
- Shri Dhananjay Chauhan (Socheng Block) presented on use of TLM in classroom transaction, emphasizing the importance of contextualized learning materials for diverse learners.
- Shri Rajiv Engti (Lumbajong Block) spoke on ICT integration in FLN.
- Shri Deben Hakmaosa (Lumbanjong Block) spoke on use of TLM in classroom transaction.



Following this, Shri Subhra Das, Lecturer, DIET, K/A presented DIET's Best Practices, highlighting institutional innovation for teacher's development.

A special feedback and reflection session was conducted to gather participants' experience, suggestions and learnings from the conclave.

- Participants shared how the sessions inspired them to implement innovative pedagogies in their schools.
- Many teachers appreciated the interactive sessions and requested more opportunities for block-level follow-up training.
- Feedback highlighted the need for continuous peer-learning platform and leadership mentoring for teachers.
- The session concluded with a collective reflection on the importance of sustained professional development and collaborative networks for educational improvement.
